**TA Instruments-ICTAC Award**

The Award will be made to the candidate who has, in the judgement of the ICTAC Scientific Awards Committee and the ICTAC Council, made an outstanding contribution to the science of thermal analysis and/or shown significant leadership to the profession of thermal analysis. The Award consists of a plaque, an honorarium of \$1000 and travel and living expenses at the 15<sup>th</sup> ICTAC Congress and the Congress registration fee.

**SETARAM-ICTAC Award for Calorimetry**

The Award will be made to the person who has, in the judgement of the ICTAC Scientific Awards Committee and the ICTAC Council, made an outstanding contribution to the science of calorimetry or who has shown significant leadership in or made an outstanding contribution to the profession of calorimetry. The Award will consist of a plaque, an honorarium of \$1000 and travel and living expenses at the 15<sup>th</sup> ICTAC Congress and the Congress registration fee.

The previous winners of this award are: Ingemar Wadsö, Sweden (2000); Hiroshi Suga, Japan (2004) and Ingolf Lamprecht, Germany (2008).

Nominations should include a letter of nomination by the proposer, a letter of consent to the nomination by the candidate, curriculum vitae, list of publications and any other relevant supporting material. Up to two additional letters of support may also be supplied. ## **ICTAC Young Scientist Award**

This Award will be presented to an outstanding young scientist working in the field of thermal analysis and calorimetry to enable them to present a paper based on their work at a Plenary Session of the 15<sup>th</sup> ICTAC Congress. The Award consists of a plaque, \$2000 towards travel and living expenses at the Congress and the Congress Registration Fee. Candidates must be under the age of 35 on the 31<sup>st</sup> December 2011.

Nominations should include a letter of nomination by the proposer, curriculum vitae, list of publications and a one page abstract of the paper that the candidate intends to present at the 15<sup>th</sup> ICTAC Congress.
